EXT. FRONT YARD - JENNY'S HOUSE - DAY

JENNY (10) plays. She notices a little boy, ALEX (7), watching her shyly.

JENNY

Hey. I'm Jenny.

He stares, silent. Jenny pulls a JENGA game from the box.

JENNY (CONT'D)

Heey I love this game! Wanna play?

Alex hesitantly goes to her and sits down across from her. Jenny starts to build the Jenga tower on the concrete.

ALEX

I'm Alex. Sorry, I'm... shy.

Alex fearfully glances at a house across the street. Another NEIGHBOR KID leaves a gift at the door of the house and scurries away. Jenny follows his gaze, smiles.

JENNY

A girl named Morgan lives there, right? I got a play date with her today. Is she nice?

Alex's eyes widen with terror. He starts to speak when a skinny dirty little girl, MAGGIE (7), approaches carrying a beat-up little toy basket with a few Legos at the bottom.

MAGGIE

Can you spare any Legos please? I'll take two-by-fours, two-by-twos, one-by-twos... I'll even take the L-shaped ones!

ALEX

Get outta here, Maggie. I'm dry.

Maggie scurries off to the next house.

JENNY

Oookay... so Morgan, is she nice?

Alex sees the eyes of MORGAN (11) peek out from the blinds.

ALEX

Yes nice, very nice! I'd better go.

JENNY

But I just got the tower built!

ALEX

Yeah maybe another time, um...
(whispers)
Never blink or turn your back!

Alex scurries off. Jenny sits there, confused.
